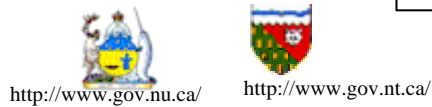
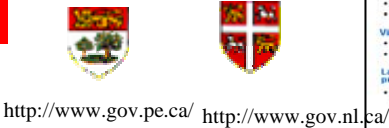
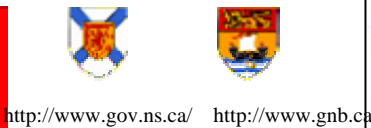

Description: The first multi-jurisdictional, on-line registry service in Canada, providing Personal Property Registration for the Provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and Labrador, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut.

Solution Specialist role included:

- Clarifying the legal and regulatory framework required to migrate from a paper-based system;
- Recommending the business model for including fee structures to ensure cost effective service delivery;
- Communication strategy, transition management, and training for internal and external stakeholders
- Working with the Canadian Credit Bureau in the initial design of the Atlantic Personal Property Registry System (Canadian collateral registry) as a stakeholder in the development and use of the Registry System - Public & Legal Administration - 1997-2000;
- As Nova Scotia Registrar of Personal Property worked closely with all provincial Registrars of Deeds and private sector technology solution providers and stakeholders, ensuring effective electronic personal property registry operation. Managed the service provider contract and was the Nova Scotia liaison to the service provider and the client community
- Designing post implementation surveys, that indicated overwhelming client satisfaction; Extensive consultation the transition to the new electronic environment was embraced and has met all projected forecasts.
- This legislative and business transformation project resulted in the redeployment of 40 staff to core services and programs.
- Client Relationship Representative on the Public/Private partnership between Unisys and the four Atlantic provinces – Atlantic Canada On Line (ACOL)
- Advised provincial governments in electronic registration and records management, resulting in strong business relationships with key decision makers
